A report of the Official AAU Masters Swimming Committee publication was given by the Editor, June Krauser, who reported a circulation close to 1100. It was approved by the committee to raise the subscription rate to \$5.00 due to the increase in postage and inflation.

Historian, Hans Anderson, reported on the history of the Masters Swimming Program.

Watson Lawrence gave a report for Anne Adams on the Championship Meet Recommendations.

Under New Business a motion was made and seconded to change the 1500/1650 and 400/500 freestyle events in the National Program. Motion failed.

A motion was made and seconded to add a new age group 20-24. Motion failed.

The Rinconada Masters and Santa Clara Swim Club received the bid for the 1974 National Masters LC Swimming Championships to be held at the Santa Clara International Pool on Sept. 6, 7, 8

Watson Lawrence proposed the following resolution: All members of this Committee unanimously would like for Dr. Ransom Arthur to continue as chairman of this Committee but in as much as he is not present, and in accordance with AAU directives, a person present must be elected.

Watson Lawrence, Hans Anderson and June Krauser were nominated with June Krauser being elected chairman.

Other items of business were discussed as follows:

1. Watson Lawrence wants to contact the YMCA's in connection with spreading the base of the program.
2. It was suggested that a pool of coaches be established for the purpose of answering swimmer's questions about training and training programs.
3. Mildred Anderson volunteered to work on a Masters training manual, who to contact, etc.
4. Masters Swimming must continue to be fun.
5. Pat Clinton is working on a Masters Swimming Directory.
6. A Masters Meet to be held in Houston, TX was announced.
7. Watson Lawrence has volunteered to seek a National sponsor for Masters Swimming.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 pm.
