- 3. Masters Swimming Legislation was discussed with the following action:

- 5. 1975 Short Course National Championships were awarded to the Florida Gold Coast AAU to be held at the SHOF pool on May 16, 17, and 18.at Ft. Lauderdale. 1975 Long Course National Championships were awarded to the Southeastern AAU to be held at the University of Tennessee at Knorville on August 29-31. CODE
- 6. Swimming Legislation pertaining to Masters Swimming was discussed with the following action:

- 7. Legislation submitted by Calif. late was discussed and voted on with all items failing. A motion was made, seconded and carried that team championship awards shall not be awarded at the 1975 SC or LC Nationals.
- 8. The new AAU Registration form was exclained.
- 9. The Participation Fee was discussed and the following formula was moved, seconded and carried:
  - 10% to the Swimming Hall of Fame
  - 30% to the National Masters Swimming Committee Support
  - 60% to the National Masters Championship Support
