## **Action Items**

1. MSC to change selection committee from three to five members to avoid showing

favoritism or appearance of impropriety.

2. MSC to begin 8 regional two-part clinics (2 hour Coaches Mentor Clinic & a 4 hour Swimmer Clinic) designed to motivate & train coaches, educate swimmers, retain and increase membership. Each of the 8 clinics will receive \$500 seed money to assist in bringing in an outside the area "Mentor" to work with the area coaches.

3. MSC to purchase 2 Snooper underwater cameras (\$800) to service 24 clubs for one month each. Priority for use of the Snoopers will be given to programs who host USMS

sponsored clinics.

4. MSC to request \$750 to rent booth space at the ASCA Clinic in the effort to recruit new Masters coaches.

## Sub-committee Reports

1. Coach of the Year

A chair of this sub-committee is still needed.

b. Criteria of selection for Coach of the Year will be review and possibly updated next year.

2. On Deck Coaching

Mo Chambers and Loraine Martinelli are now co-chairs of this sub-committee.

Krista Phillips reported:

a. Short Course Nationals had excellent participation. Baseball hats were given instead of shirts and were well received.

b. Long Course Nationals was not organized and no on-deck coaching was offered because she couldn't attend or schedule someone to direct it. Improvements will be made by getting back to sending out postcards requesting volunteers, and giving assignments. In the next year, a mailing list from coaches checked on the USMS registration form will be used to solicit volunteers for On Deck Coaching. A MACA database list of over 250 names is also available.

c. USMS Convention workouts were covered with 3 coaches each day. Copies of the

workouts are available at the House of Delegates.

d. Coaches Hospitality has not been consistent at the past few USMS Nationals. The coaches would like it to be a standard program and are taking the concept to Championship Committee.

3. Video Library

4. Clinics

Krista Phillips head this sub-committee. The Clinic Series History, Purpose, and Objectives were reviewed. A Fitness Clinic format is complete and will be available in the Coaches Manual. The Stroke Development, Competition, & Open Water Clinics are still being developed and should be available by next years convention.

a. MSC to begin 8 regional two-part clinics (2 hour Coaches Mentor Clinic & a 4 hour Swimmer Clinic) designed to motivate & train coaches, educate swimmers, retain and increase membership. Each of the 8 clinics will receive \$500 seed money to assist in bringing in an outside the area "Mentor" to work with the area coaches.

An application form will be developed. The Coaches Chairman & Clinic Sub-

committee Chairman will make selections if more than 8 clinics apply.

b. MSC to purchase 2 Snooper underwater cameras (\$800) to service 24 clubs for one month each. Priority for use of the Snoopers will be given to programs who host USMS sponsored clinics.

5. USMS/MACA/ASCA Coaches Manual

A 3-Ring binder format Coaches Manual has been developed in a cooperative effort between USMS, ASCA, & MACA. Robert Zeitner is heading the project and is asking for input before November 1. Once compiled and updated the manual will be sold for approximately \$20 to cover expenses plus \$1-2 for future enhancements. Suggestions were made to use Registration mailing of 'coaches box' to solicit. Orders for the book will be the same as for other USMS publications. However, Dorthy Donnelley will forward orders to Robert Zeitner to prevent double mailing of such a large document. to mail the packet. This is also done to reduce overprinting and having more material for Dorothy to keep in stock. A yearly update for the manual is in the planning stages. We ask that newsletters run a special ad or article informing membership of this outstanding source of coaching information.

## Communications/Liaison

Communications is a new sub-committee being developed to further the coaches committee scope outside of USMS. A chair of this sub-committee is still needed.

MACA Update: The Masters Aquatic Coaches Association has developed a detailed plan of direction (VVMOST system). Lucky Meisenheimer has completed a detailed Coach & Program survey of over 100 Masters clubs. Election of new officers will be done at USMS SC Nationals.

ASCA Update: Judy Bonning reported that ASCA continues to offer Masters Coaches Schools and certification throughout the country. In 1995 three schools were offered (Napa Clinic, ASCA-Clinic, & USMS Convention). In 1996 four are already planned and others may be added (Napa, USMS SC Nationals, ASCA Clinic, & USMS Convention). Keith Bell recommended trying to recruit more well qualified USS coaches to get involve with Masters.

MSC to request \$750 to rent booth space at the ASCA Clinic in the effort to recruit new Masters coaches.

On-Line Exposure: Quarterly information releases will be put out by the committee chair to Dave Tree to be disseminated across the net as widely as possible.
