

REPORT FROM COLONIES ZONE MEETING

1. A Colonies Zone schedule was distributed, amended, and updated.
2. The zone mailing list was distributed. LMSC representatives were asked to check that the two contacts per LMSC were correct. If not, changes were made. The zone representative will distribute the updated list.
3. Distribution of newsletters was discussed.
 - a. The zone representative should be receiving newsletters from all LMSCs and as many clubs as possible.
 - b. Each LMSC should send newsletter to all other LMSCs. Clubs may want to do this also.
 - c. The zone representative will publish a zone newsletter and schedule every 2 months.
 - (1) The zone rep. gets most information on meets from these newsletters.
 - (2) It would be more efficient and timely if each LMSC or meet director will send the zone rep. meet dates and contact person as soon as the date is determined.
4. The Zone Championship Meet was discussed.
 - a. LMSC for Maryland presented a bid which was accepted.
 - b. Date: April 14-16, 1989
 - c. Place: U. of Md. Baltimore County (UMBC), Baltimore, MD (25 yd 8 lane pool with a diving well for warm-up).
 - d. The possibility and advantages of using a 25 meter pool for the Zone Champ. were discussed.
 - e. The Zone Champ. for 1990 was briefly mentioned. Having SC Nationals in California will make the Zone Champ. important. Potomac Valley indicated interest in this meet and will investigate facilities, etc.
5. The rest of the time was spent discussing elections of USMS officers at next year's convention.
 - a. Nominating process
 - b. Methods for and importance of zone rep. keeping the LMSC representatives informed and seeking advice from the LMSC reps.
 - c. List of possible nominations for office was begun.
 - d. Importance of each LMSC being represented at the convention in Portland was stressed.
