

Registration Committee - 9/18/86 (convened 9:10 AM)

The new registration cards have been sent out; notify Gene Donner of any changes of name or address of Registration Chairman. He will have new notebooks for LMSC reps. here at convention; one has been printed for Reg'n Chairman, LMSC Chairman, and Top Ten Chairman of each LMSC. It was suggested that Gene send a form in May to Reg'n Chairmen so that he will be aware of any changes for the following year; forms and cards could then be sent to LMSC's earlier.

Reg'n Chairmen were reminded that the new National registration fee is \$5.00.

Enid noted that there are currently 22,960 registered Masters swimmers.

A motion was made that the gross number of swimmers registered by an LMSC as of June 15 (or the number registered by that LMSC during the preceding year, whichever number is greater) will be the number of swimmers used to determine how many voting delegates that LMSC is entitled to at the annual convention. This was voted in unanimously by the committee. This is a policy of the Registration Committee. However, Tom Boak requested that it be passed by Law & Legislation for ratification anyway because it deals with certification of delegates.

Various examples were brought up by different LMSC's of situations where disciplinary action against particular swimmers had been desired or carried out. There is justification in the rulebook for such action, but it was agreed that enforcement can be difficult, particularly if a swimmer jumps to another LMSC after being banned from swimming in one. Enid volunteered to keep an unofficial list of such individuals if LMSC's will provide her with input.

Enid requested immediate notification of Registration Chairmen's changes of names and/or addresses.

A motion was made that all new swimmers may begin registering October 1st; the registration year will remain November 1 - October 31. Clubs should re-register during the month of September. It passed unanimously and will be sent to Law & Legislation as a substitute recommendation for the one proposed by San Diego Imperial. (Thus, swimmers registering during August and September will be registering for the "old" year.)

The question of obtaining programs for computerizing registrations came up. Nancy Ridout has a program for Top 10 and registrations for IBM; Enid has one for Top 10 for Apple. Both would be available for a fee. Leo Letendre suggested that Tom set up a committee to obtain/develop software for programs both at the local and national levels which would be compatible with each other and thereby usable nationwide for USMS purposes. Leo was made Chairman if such a committee is established; suggested members of such a committee are: Chris Carey, Enid Uhrich, Nancy Ridout, George McVey, and Bob Smith.

Tom Boak raised the issue of Registration Chairman registering youngsters in USMS (some as young as ten years old) and what this could conceivably do to our insurance rates. He feels this practice is against the principles of USMS.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 AM.
